Questions 1, 4 and 7 (Varied Fluency)

Developing Write letters in alphabetical order. Using all letters and either lower-case or capital letters.

Expected Write letters in alphabetical order. Using all letters and a mixture of lower-case and capital letters.

Greater Depth Write words in alphabetical order, sometimes by the first two letters of the words.

Questions 2, 5 and 8 (Varied Fluency)

Developing Identify errors in sentences. Using all letters and easily decodable words.

Expected Identify errors in sentences. Using all letters and mostly phonetically decodable words.

Greater Depth Identify errors in sentences. Sometimes ordering words by the first two letters of words. Using all letters, including words that are not easily phonetically decodable.

Questions 3, 6 and 9 (Application and Reasoning)

Developing Identify and explain an error in alphabetical ordering. Using all letters and easily decodable words.

Expected Identify and explain an error in alphabetical ordering. Using all letters and mostly phonetically decodable words.

Greater Depth Identify and explain an error in alphabetical ordering. Sometimes ordering words by the first two letters of words. Using all letters, including words that are not easily phonetically decodable.
