Write four riddles each describing an animal for your partner to guess. Your riddle must include a list of at least three characteristics of the animal you have chosen.

For example:

I am thinking of an animal that has wrinkly skin, weighs between three and four tons, has poor eyesight and has a nose that can lift a human. What am I?

Use the animals in the image to help you or an animal of your choice.





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I am thinking of an animal that is a herbivore, has multi-coloured skin, eats from Acacia trees and has a tongue that can grow up to fifty centimetres long. What am I? (Giraffe)

I am thinking of an animal that is a carnivore, has multiple sets of teeth through their lifetime, is a reptile, are sometimes called living fossils and have webbed feet.

What am I? (Crocodile)

I am thinking of an animal that can live to 150 years old, lays eggs, is a cold-blooded reptile, hibernates through the winter and the largest living species lives in the Galapagos Islands. What am I? (Tortoise)

I am thinking of an animal that has multi-coloured skin, has unique patterns on its skin, eats large quantities of grasses, lives in the grasslands of Africa and has a mane like a horse. What am I? (Zebra)
