


Balmoral Castle Set in Scotland, Prince Albert bought this property for Queen Victoria in 1852.	Buckingham Palace The official residence of the monarch of the United Kingdom.	Craigowan Lodge This seven-bedroom house is just a stone's throw from Balmoral Castle.	Hillsborough Castle In the heart of Northern Ireland, this house was built in the 1770s.
Palace of Holyroodhouse The official residence of the monarch in Scotland.	Sandringham House This estate in Norfolk passed to Queen Elizabeth II from her father, King George VI, in 1952.	Windsor Castle The largest occupied castle in Europe, founded by William the Conqueror in the 11th century.	Birkhall A beautiful private residence in Scotland.
Clarence House This London residence, next to St. James's Palace, was the private office of the Prince of Wales.	Highgrove House King Charles III was made a 'tenant for life' of Highgrove House. It is close to Gatcombe Park.	Llwynywermod Previously, this Welsh home was owned by relatives of Anne Boleyn, the second wife of Henry VIII.	Tamarisk House This home on the Isle of Scilly also belongs to the Duke and Duchess of Cornwall.
Kensington Palace Back in 1689, King William III and Queen Mary II bought the London mansion for £20,000.	Anmer Hall Given as a wedding gift to William and Kate from Queen Elizabeth II, and is their country home.	Gatcombe Park This Grade II listed property in the south west of England was given to Princess Anne in 1976.	St James's Palace The official residence of Princess Anne and also of Princess Beatrice of York.
The Royal Lodge This house, close to Windsor Castle, was a residence of Queen Elizabeth the Queen Mother from 1952.	Bagshot Park This 120-room London mansion is home to the Earl and Countess of Wessex.
