Ask the children to sort counters into hoops, bowls or groups. Children may sort by size, type, colour, etc. Discuss how they have sorted the counters.

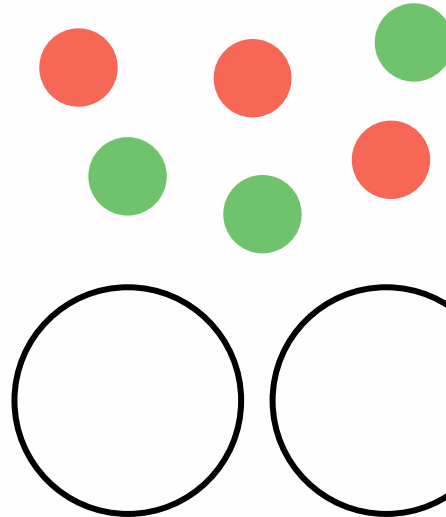
Writing

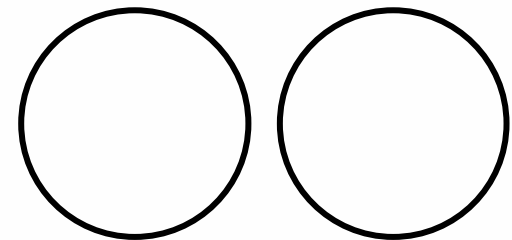

Advice and ideas

Construction

Children to sort the blocks into two sorting hoops. They may sort by colour, size or style. Encourage children to discuss their ideas and reasons.

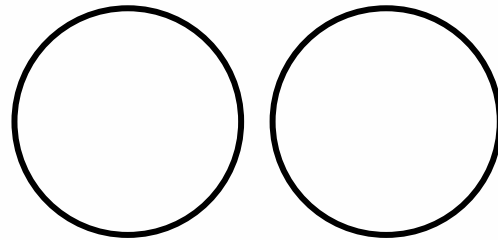
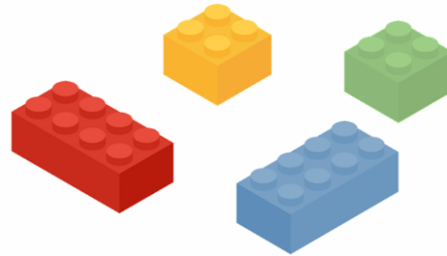
Creative

Sand

Provide a selection of different tools for the children to sort. They may sort by colour, purpose, size, etc. Encourage the children to explain how they have sorted them.

Provide a selection of different shells for the children to sort. They may sort by colour, shape, texture, etc. Encourage the children to explain how they have sorted them.

Sort the tools in the sand.



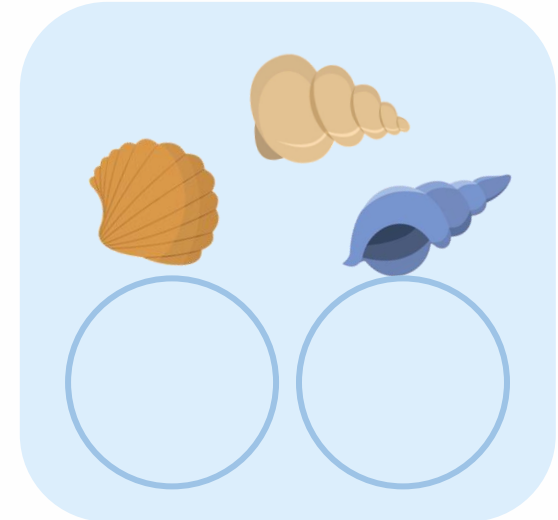
