## Supporting Activities

## Position in the First Quadrant

Shape Shaker: An activity for a group to use in class or intervention to help children's understanding of position in the first quadrant.

Resources: You will need multiple $10 \times 10$ coordinate grids, 10sided dice, shape cards, whiteboards and whiteboard pens.
Activity: In pairs, roll the dice twice to create a coordinate. Plot the point on their grid and then pick a shape card. Create the shape on the coordinate grid and label each coordinate.

## Example:

The digits 4 and 5 are rolled on the dice to create the coordinate $(4,5)$.
Plot the $x$ and $y$ coordinate on their grid.
Choose a square from the shape cards and plot on the grid to make the shape. Label the other coordinates.

Repeat choosing different coordinates and shapes.

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
